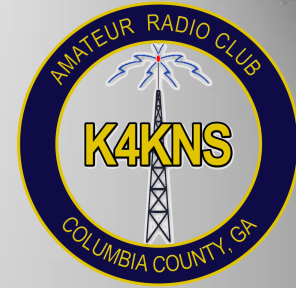


# *Inflatable Antenna Towers*

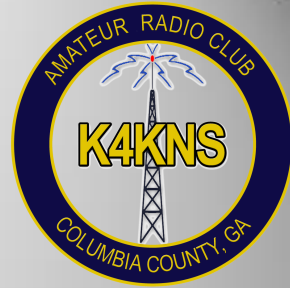

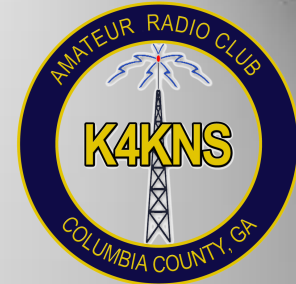

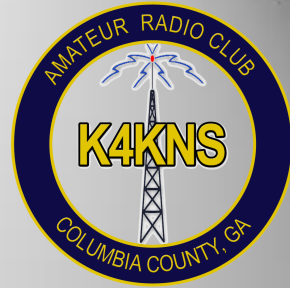

## RESOLUTION 16-1232

### OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY, GEORGIA FOR USE OF COUNTY OWNED COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT LOCATED AT 7059 COBBHAM ROAD

THIS RESOLUTION adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Columbia County, Georgia (the "Board").

**WHEREAS**, each year Columbia County citizens face natural and technological threats which are all potentially dangerous to life, health and property; and

**WHEREAS**, various and redundant forms of communications are critical to the preparation, the mitigation, monitoring, warning, response, and recovery of said threats; and

**WHEREAS**, the Amateur Radio Community can provide an additional method of communication prior to, during, and after routine and emergency events; and

**WHEREAS**, Amateur Radio is a vital part of the Columbia County Emergency Operations Center during activations; and

**WHEREAS**, The Columbia County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Columbia County Emergency Management Agency to maintain control of county owned communications equipment currently managed by the Columbia County Emergency Management Agency and to coordinate use of said county owned equipment with the Amateur Radio Club of Columbia County, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, The Amateur Radio Club of Columbia County, Inc. will utilize said equipment to enhance the amateur radio communications capability within Columbia County; and

**WHEREAS**, For the benefit of providing an additional communications path to allow licensed amateur radio operators to pass traffic which could be critical to the existence of life, health and property and improve the overall preparedness, response and recovery to incidents affecting citizens; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board and it is hereby resolved by the authority of same that the Columbia County Emergency Management Agency shall have the authority to coordinate the use of county owned communications equipment managed by the Columbia County Emergency Management Agency with the Amateur Radio Club of Columbia County, Inc. and properly licensed, by the Federal Communications Commission, amateur radio operators.
